### C. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

#### District Update

Test drilling for the Blue Jay Groundwater well is currently out to bid. The bid opening will be on March 4, 2021.

Multiple pilot projects have been completed to improve the District's wastewater treatment process. Final lab results are being analyzed and a recommendation will be prepared.

Manhole Inflow Reduction Project #225 is out to bid. The bid opening will be on March 11, 2021.

The Tesla batteries for the energy storage project have been delivered. Necessary maintenance has been completed on the electrical systems at the Grass Valley Wastewater Treatment Plant that will enable the installation of the batteries.

Spyglass reservoir and slope stabilization design is 100% complete. District staff are finalizing the operational considerations for taking the tank offline. Once this is determined the specifications will be finalized and the project will be put out to bid.

### Lake Update

As of February 12, 2021, Lake Arrowhead was 3.32 feet below full at 5,103.38. The new water year started October 1<sup>st</sup> and the area has received 8.96” of precipitation which is 54% of normal. The District does not currently have plans to purchase additional supplemental water but will continue to evaluate the conditions.
