

ORDINANCE NO. 19

ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
LAKE ARROWHEAD COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT,
SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING
SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1 ESTABLISHING
AND PROVIDING FOR WATER RATES AND CHARGES

WHEREAS, a public hearing on a proposed change in water rates has been held in the time and manner required by law and the Board of Directors has received and considered all testimony material thereto:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Ordinance No. 1 establishing and providing for water rates and charges on a bi-monthly basis.

Section 2. Amendment. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

METERED RATES AND CHARGES
OTHER THAN AGRICULTURAL

<u>BI-MONTHLY QUANTITY CHARGES</u>	<u>BI-MONTHLY RATES</u>
0 - 1,000 cubic feet	\$18.00
Over 1,000 cubic feet per 100 cubic feet	\$ 1.85

AGRICULTURAL RATES AND CHARGES
(METERED AND UNTREATED WATER SERVICE)

<u>BI-MONTHLY QUANTITY CHARGES</u>	<u>BI-MONTHLY RATES</u>
Per 100 acre feet	\$7,500.00

FIRE HYDRANT CHARGES

<u>SIZE OF WATER MAIN</u>	<u>BI-MONTHLY RATES</u>
Water mains 6" and above	\$6.00
Water mains less than 6"	\$4.00


FIRE HYDRANT CHARGES
ON PRIVATE SERVICES

The fire hydrant charge for hydrants located on private service mains shall be \$2.00 bi-monthly for each inch in size of the private water main.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.


Section 4. Publication. The Secretary is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published once in full in a newspaper of general circulation, printed, published and circulated in the District.
