

ORDINANCE NO. 24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
LAKE ARROWHEAD COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
ENACTING REGULATIONS CONCERNING A WATER CROSS-
CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Title 17 of the California Administrative Code,
Sections 7583-7605, inclusive require that all public water
suppliers adopt and implement a cross-connection control program
in order to prevent potential pollution of the water supply; and,

WHEREAS, the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District, as
a public agency supplying water, desires to implement said program
and adopt Rules and Regulations pertaining thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the foregoing Recitals are true and correct.
2. Title 17 of the California Administrative Code,
Section 7583-7605, inclusive is hereby adopted as if set forth in
full and incorporated herein.

3. No water service shall be installed or maintained by
the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District to any premises on
which there exists or is suspected to exist actual or potential
cross-connections between the public water supply and other
piping, fixtures, appliances, equipment, drains or any system
which might cause contamination or pollution through backflow or
back-siphonage, unless such service is protected by the

installation of a backflow prevention device which is acceptable to the District.

4. It shall be the water user's responsibility to provide, install, test and maintain any and all required devices at said water user's expense.


5. The District shall assist the water user in evaluating the user's system to determine if a backflow device is needed, and if so, which type is most appropriate. The District shall maintain a list of approved devices. The District shall also have staff available to make "in plant" or "on premises" inspections at the water user's invitation. These inspections are specifically to assist the water user to understand the user's plumbing problems and to suggest remedies.

6. Regular tests and inspections as required by the District shall be performed on backflow prevention devices only by competent inspectors certified by the Director of Public Health, County of San Bernardino, and approved by the District. Whenever a test indicates a malfunction or an improperly working device, the device shall be repaired immediately and retested.


7. Records of such tests, servicing and repair shall be kept by the water user and made available on request to the District.

8. Failure to comply with the foregoing provisions shall be cause for the refusal or the immediate discontinuance of service to the premises to insure the health and safety of all water users of the domestic water system.




