

ORDINANCE NO. 27

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
THE LAKE ARROWHEAD COMMUNITY SERVICES
DISTRICT REGARDING CRESTLINE-LAKE ARROWHEAD
WATER AGENCY EMERGENCY WATER SHORTAGE AND
CONSERVATION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency has adopted its Ordinance No. 44, an Ordinance declaring an emergency water shortage and establishing water conservation program; and

WHEREAS, said Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency provides water to the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District for utilization in the Deer Lodge Park area; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance No. 44 provides that the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency may surcharge the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District for excess consumption; and

WHEREAS, the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District finds it necessary to pass on any such increased cost to the user which has resulted in said surcharge;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. That the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District does hereby determine to pass on to those services in Deer Park Lodge the actual amount of any surcharge for excess usage levied by the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency upon the Lake Arrowhead

Community Services District relating to excess usage
by said services in the Deer Park Lodge Area.
