RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF LAKE ARROWHEAD COMMUNITY SERVICES
DISTRICT RELEASING THE CRESTLINE-LAKE
ARROWHEAD WATER AGENCY FROM CLAIMS OF
SERVICE DUPLICATION IN REGARD TO ITS
PROPOSED DEER LODGE PARK TRANSMISSION
LINE

WHEREAS, the area known as Deer Lodge Park, served by the Deer Lake Water Corporation, lies within the boundaries of the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency; and

WHEREAS, that area is in need of supplemental water, and the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency Board of Directors has informed this District that it is now ready to go to bid on a transmission line which would bring such supplemental water to the Deer Lodge Park area; and

WHEREAS, this Board is informed by representatives of the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency that the most efficient and economical route for such a Deer Lodge Park transmission line is along Sonoma Drive and Brentwood Drive, which route runs through portions of this District; and

WHEREAS, this District has provided excellent water distribution facilities to serve the areas along Sonoma Drive and Brentwood Drive, and has no need for additional water distribution facilities in those areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency has officially adopted a policy preventing any service from its proposed Deer Lodge Park

transmission line to areas within the boundaries of the District; and


WHEREAS, the Agency is willing to proceed with its Deer Lodge Park transmission line project and to provide wholesale water to the residents and property owners of the Deer Lodge Park area through the facilities of the Deer Lake Water Corporation, provided that the District releases the Agency from all claims of service duplication pursuant to Sections 1501 et seq. of the California Public Utilities Code; and

WHEREAS, having received satisfactory assurances that the Agency will not serve or provide or allow the use of any water from this proposed transmission line within the boundaries of the District, the District desires to release the Agency from all claims of service duplication for constructing the proposed transmission line through its area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District that the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency is hereby released from any and all claims by this District for service duplication pursuant to California Public Utilities Code Section 1501 et seq. for the provision of water to the Deer Lodge Park area served retail water by the Deer Lake Water Corporation, and for the necessary construction, operation,


maintenance, repair and replacement of the proposed Deer Lodge Park transmission line which will, if built as planned, run through the District and transmit water to the Deer Lodge Park area.
