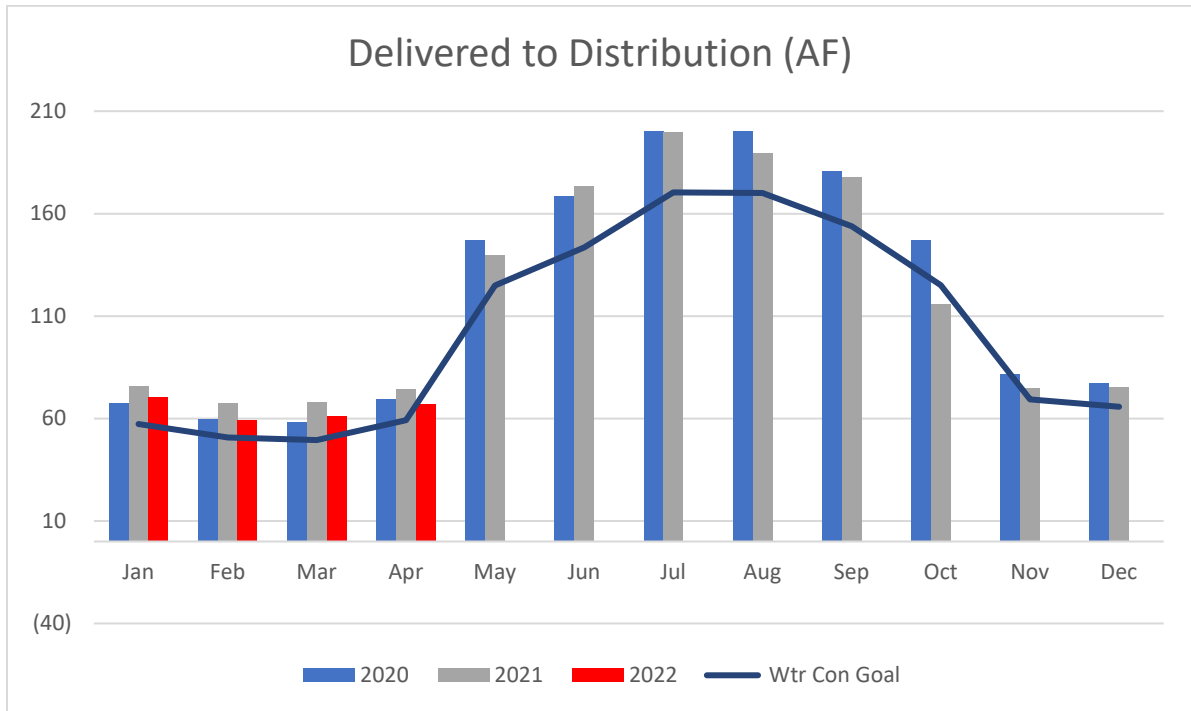
C. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

District Update

Design for the treatment and distribution of groundwater from the Blue Jay well is nearing completion. The final stage of the project will go out to bid as soon as the plans and specifications are finalized. The District is actively seeking new locations for groundwater wells. Seven new locations have been identified.

The District received grant money in the amount of \$109,000 from the State Water Resources Control Board to pay off past due balances that accrued during a specified timeframe related to COVID-19. The moratorium on water shut-offs has been lifted and all past due customers have been offered a payment plan. Additionally, the District is participating in the Low Income Household Water Assistance Program which provides funds to help pay current water and wastewater bills.

Water usage in April, 2022 was 10% lower than 2021 and 4% lower than 2020. Emergency regulations being considered by the State Water Board on May 23, 2022 may require all urban water suppliers to implement demand management measures equivalent to 10% to 20% compared to 2020. The Water Supply and Demand Assessment normally included in this memo is under a separate item in the current agenda.
