C. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Groundwater Well #2 is currently undergoing rehabilitation. This well has been out of service for two years due to water quality issues and is expected to be operational in May, 2021. This well has the capability of producing 38 acre-feet per year.

The District only received one bid for the Blue Jay Groundwater Well which was higher than budget. Staff are working with their hydrogeologist, Russell Kyle from Kyle Groundwater, to change the scope which will allow for more bidders.

Lake Update

As of April 19, 2021, Lake Arrowhead was 3.11 feet below full at 5,103.59 and falling. The new water year started October 1st and the area has received 11.91” of precipitation according to the USGS rain gage located at the Bernina Water Treatment Plant. This is 45% of normal. Typically, the area receives 92% of its precipitation by the end of April (31”). Deterministic models predict that the odds of reaching normal are essentially 0%. It is possible that a typhoon in the Pacific Ocean may bring rain to the area in early May.
