**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the General Manager of the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District (“District”) has caused a written report to be prepared and filed with the Board of Directors of the District listing each parcel of real property subject to District’s Sewer Fee, as well as the amount of such Sewer Fee and any delinquencies and penalties on such parcel, and intends to enroll the District’s Sewer Fee (for the period from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023, along with any delinquencies and penalties) on the County’s fiscal year 2022/2023 tax roll.

As the owner of real property within the District subject to the Sewer Fee, you are hereby advised that on **June 28, 2022**, a public hearing will be held by the District Board of Directors in-person and remotely, to hear and consider all objections or protests to the enrollment of the Sewer Fee and any delinquencies and penalties on the County tax roll for each affected parcel within the District. The Board of Directors’ determination shall be final. A parcel list with the proposed rate will be posted on our website at [www.lakearrowheadcsd.com](http://www.lakearrowheadcsd.com) prior to the hearing.

On or before August 10, 2022, the General Manager shall file with the Auditor of the County of San Bernardino a copy of the final report adopted by the Board of Directors. The County Auditor shall enter the amount of the Sewer Fee and penalties due, if any, for each affected parcel as they appear on the current assessment roll. The County Tax Collector shall include the amount of the Sewer Fee, with any delinquencies and penalties, on property tax bills for each affected parcel and collect the charges and penalties, if any, in the same manner as property taxes.
