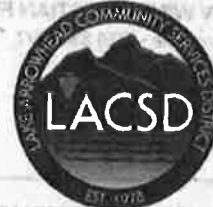

The bids will be publicly read shortly after 2:00 p.m. on May 15, 2019. There will be a MANDATORY job walk at 10:00 a.m. on May 6, 2019. All interested Contractors shall meet at the District Offices at, 27307 State Hwy 189, Blue Jay, CA, at 10:00 a.m. prior to the start of the conference. The work consists of providing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, facilities, transportation and incidentals necessary to construct: Remove or pulverize existing concrete and remove steel reinforcement, Install 2-1/2" of AC Pavement PG 64-16 3/8" over 4" of Class 2 Base or Pulverized Concrete with a relative compaction (RC) of 95% minimum. Regrade, to new elevations, removal and reconstruction of concrete curbs, and replace parking area markings and striping. The site of the work is located in: Lake Arrowhead, California.
